Spring is finally here! We had record or near record snowfall over the winter. It still remains to be seen if we have flooding or damage to our roads and streams from snow melting and runoff.

This winter has been very difficult for wild game in a lot of areas of Wyoming. It has been reported there will be less licenses issued in some areas due to low fawn and calf survival. I have heard that extra licenses maybe put in a second draw. It would be a good idea to check with Game & Fish. A lot of information I have will be outdated by the time the newsletter comes out.

I will mention a few things to check out with Game & Fish. Seminars on large carnivores to teach safety and awareness are going on around the state - check with Game & Fish on times in your area.

There are mortality studies going on in different areas of the state also. After this harsh winter I would expect license numbers in certain areas to change if not this year then maybe next year.

It is time to get boats, campers and fishing gear ready for summer fun. It is a good idea to make sure all licenses and safety regulations are in order. It may prevent having a bad day on one of your outings.

Please Note that Dennis French has resigned. At this time we would like to thank him for all his help and service, and wish him well in all his future endeavors.

All of the By-Law Referendums passed overwhelmingly. Here is what the new changes mean.

1. There is no more complimentary memberships. With the event of the Web Site, there is no need for such memberships.
2. Four Board Officers must now be present for business to be conducted at meetings, instead of just two.
3. WSSA must now hold two membership meetings each year, instead of just one. {one in the spring and one in the fall}
4. As per the decision of the Board of Directors, the elections can be held either in the spring, or the fall meeting of the given year.
5. At least 60 Days notice is to be given prior to Membership Meetings, and elections must held at such meetings. Clear and Specific guidelines are to be contained in the policy manual with regard to the election process. This is very similar to what the By-Laws say about the Dues, Fees, and State Championship Match Procedures.


